Normally, truck cranes have 2 different cabs. One cab is for controlling the crane and the other is for driving the truck when the unit is in transport mode. This is due to the fact that the crane can be driven easily from one place to another. Additionally, the cranes could be transported to various construction locations on the road since they could drive themselves and this eliminates the need for extra transport vehicles. Being able to travel on their own really lessens transport expenses at the end of the day. One disadvantage of a truck crane is that it is not stable enough sitting on tires alone in order to be able to lift the major loads which a hydraulic crane can handle. Hence, in order to fix this issue, outriggers could be extended from the deck. The outriggers make use of hydraulic pressure to be able to slightly lift the truck off of the ground, making it stable and balanced. Crawler cranes feature huge tracks on the bottom of the crane. These massive tracks are like the ones seen on other construction equipment such as backhoes and bulldozers. The tracks enable the crane to successfully move around a construction locations.
